



## Family Counselor Position for Family First Program

Are you a great problem solver, love to coach people, and are looking for a career move? We are looking for LPC, LCPC, or LMSW providers, experienced in working with children and parents who would like to be trained in a research-based program. This position will have a focus on counseling that involves working in the home and helping parents with children with serious emotional disturbances (SED). You will work in the home directly with the children and the parents once you are trained and certified in The Family First Program (FFP). This is considered a full-time, salaried position.

- Number of hours: approximately 30 hours a week (some more; some less)
- Hours working: flexible schedule, ability to work around personal commitments, may include some weekends, phone/text availability for parents
- Number of clients: only 3 - 5 families at one time
- Office: your car is your office; we supply a work tablet
- Mileage: we typically work with families within a 50-mile radius of Boise. We do not reimburse for mileage as it is considered a part of your salary. (You can keep track of your mileage for tax write-off purposes.)
- Gross pay: \$6,000/mo (\$72,000/year) after trial period and certification
- Training/Trial Period: Up to one month of training with Michelle is required to ensure a good fit as a certified Family First Counselor. (This training is paid hourly at \$35/hour.)

Training consists of :

- Reviewing 4 training modules on our online Learning Management System (LMS)
- Review all information and videos on our LMS
- Follow-up Zoom call(s) with Michelle
- In-person safety training
- One week of in-person training with Michelle as you drive together to visit homes (up to 30 hours)

A qualified applicant must

- Have a clean background check
- Hold a current license in Idaho (or in the process of transferring from another state)
- Be willing to work in homes as well as potentially see clients in the office

- Be self-motivated and organized as you will take an active role in treatment planning, program growth, and community services.

Benefits include:

- Training and certified in Family First
- Safety training in Handle with Care®
- 24/7 access to our LMS
- Counseling office and supplies - available for clients on the side (minimal; optional)
- Health insurance
- Paid time off (up to 2 weeks after 90 days; must schedule with families to make it work)
