



## Up-coming Family Counselor Position for Family First Program

Are you a great problem solver, love to coach people, and are looking for a career move? We are looking for LPC, LCPC, or LMSW providers **all over Idaho**, experienced in working with children and parents who would like to be trained in a research-based program. This position, upcoming in the future, will have a focus on counseling that involves working in the home and helping parents with children with serious emotional disturbances (SED) in your area. You will work in the home directly with the children and the parents once you are trained and certified in The Family First Program (FFP). Healthy Foundations, Inc. is a community-based organization that provides mental health counseling, the Family First Program, and parent training as part of the YES program Intensive Home and Community Based Services (IHCBS). Because this is a new service in Idaho, you are welcome to work with us to raise awareness of this service in your community. The more families in your area that know about and are in need of this service, the faster the position could turn into full-time and salaried. In the meantime, this could work in addition to a small counseling caseload. This position is perfect for a counselor who would like to work independently and be in control of their time and schedule.

This position would start as part-time

- Number of hours: approximately 5-15 hours (varies by week)
- Hours working: flexible schedule, ability to work around personal commitments, may include some weekends, phone/text availability for parents
- Number of clients: 1-2 families is considered part-time (3-5 is full-time)
- Office: your car is your office; we supply a work tablet
- Mileage: you will be expected to work with families within a 50-mile radius of your location. We do not reimburse for mileage as it is considered a part of your pay. (You can keep track of your mileage for tax write-off purposes.)
- Pay: \$50/hour for direct client hours
- Training/Trial Period: Up to one month of training with Michelle is required to ensure a good fit as a certified Family First Counselor. (This training is paid at \$35/hour.) Training consists of :
  - Reviewing 4 training modules on our online Learning Management System (LMS)

- Review all information and videos on our LMS
- Follow-up Zoom call(s) with Michelle
- In-person safety training (in our Boise office)
- One week of in-person training with Michelle as you drive together in the Boise area to visit homes (approximately 30 hours)

Once the position becomes salaried (after a waiting list has been established in your area)

- Number of hours: approximately 30 hours a week (some more; some less)
- Number of clients: 3 - 5 families at one time
- Gross pay: \$6,000/mo (\$72,000/year)
- Health insurance
- Paid time off (up to 2 weeks after 90 days; must schedule with families to make it work)

A qualified applicant must

- Have a clean background check
- Hold a current license in Idaho (or in the process of transferring from another state)
- Be willing to work in homes as well as potentially see your own clients
- Be self-motivated and organized as you will take an active role in treatment planning, program growth, and community services.
